

Dear Parent,

During week 3, your child will complete the MAP Growth assessments from NWEA using their school issued laptop. These assessments help us to understand your child's current achievement and their growth over time, allowing teachers to personalise instruction and set meaningful learning goals.

MAP Growth tests are adaptive. This means the difficulty of each question adjusts based on your child's responses—becoming more challenging when they answer correctly and easier when they find a question difficult. This approach gives us a clear and accurate picture of where your child is on their learning journey, whether they are working above, at, or below their expected year level.

The information from the MAP Growth assessments is available immediately to teachers. This allows us to identify groups of students with similar learning needs, plan targeted instruction, and monitor progress closely.

Students in years 3 -11 will complete MAP assessments twice this year in terms 1 and 3. After each assessment window, you will receive a Family Report summarising your child's progress and performance.
