What you need to know

Students can **preorder a sausage sizzle** and/or a **drink**. This needs to be done through **Flexischools** by **5:00pm Sunday 1 March**. (Pre-purchasing via Flexischools is the only way to place an order). Vegetarian sausages are available. Please note there will be no gluten free, vegan, or dairy free options available. Students can place an order from the canteen for these dietary requirements.

- Pre-K - Year 6: sausage sizzle orders and drinks will be delivered to classrooms.
- Years 7 - 12: orders will be collected from the B-Block Courtyard at lunch.

Sweet Treats: a variety of cakes and biscuits will be available for purchase on the day during recess. Prices from \$1- \$5. Purchase with tokens (order via Flexischools) or cash. Any remaining sweet treats will be sold during lunch.

Games

- Students in Years 3 - 12 will be able to participate in a variety of carnival-style games, a lolly-guessing competition, and climb onboard an NSW Fire and Rescue firetruck. Participating in each game will cost one (1) token. Tokens are available for purchase for \$1 through Flexischools.
 - To ensure all students can participate during the limited lunchtime period, a maximum of five (5) tokens may be purchased per person. Additional donations via Flexischools are welcomed and appreciated.
- For students in K-2 there will be *Fun on the Farm*. This will include carnival-style games run by our older students; no ticket is required and no tickets will be available for purchase for students in K-2. If you would like to donate to Westmead Children's Hospital, this may be done through Flexischools and is appreciated.

What to wear: students in Latimer and Ryle House may wear their sports uniform. All other students are expected to wear the usual uniform for the day.
