Dress Code

Students are to wear their swimmers underneath their full school sports uniform.

Travel Arrangements

Canteen

Students are required to bring a substantial packed lunch each day, as food cannot be eaten on the bus or at the swim centre.

Girls: One-piece swimsuit with a rash vest
Boys: Board shorts with a rash vest

Swim Caps

Swim caps will be provided by the centre and will be colour-coded according to each student's swimming level. Caps must be brought to school each day.

Hair Requirements

Girls' hair must be tied back and secured in a style that allows a swim cap to fit comfortably and properly.

Swimming Arrangements

Separate swimming lanes will be allocated for boys and girls.

Labelling

All items, including clothing and equipment, must be clearly labelled to assist with the return of lost property.
