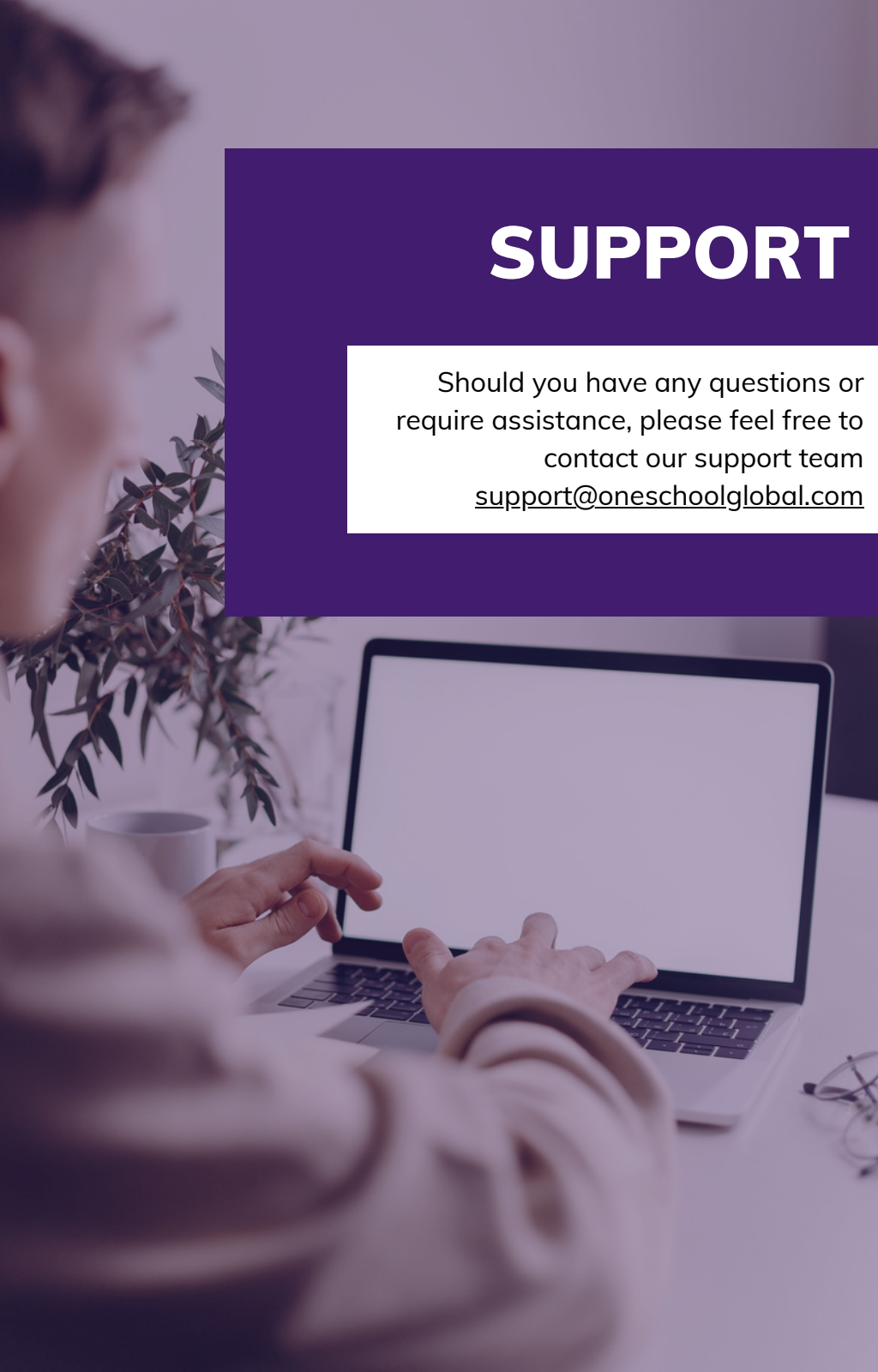

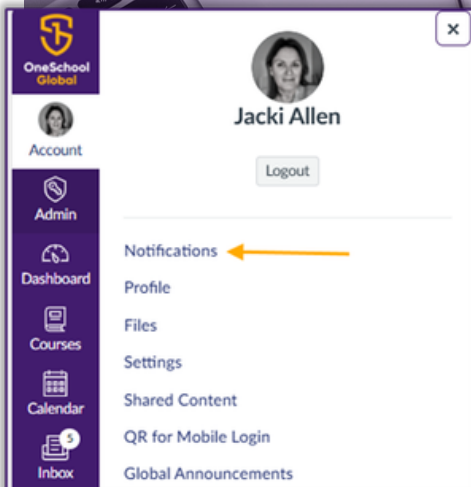

NOTIFICATIONS

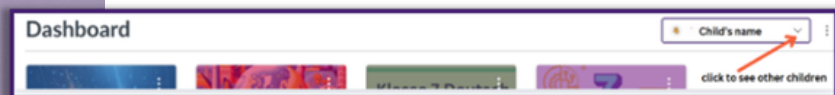
To make the most of your Canvas parent experience, you will want to adjust your notifications to ensure that you do not receive an excessive number of parent notification emails. A once-a-day or once-a-week summary will probably be frequent enough for most items. You can adjust this through clicking on your Account settings on the top left-hand side of the dashboard, and then selecting notifications settings

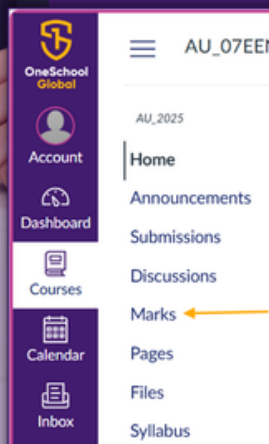


VIEWING ALL MARKS & FEEDBACK

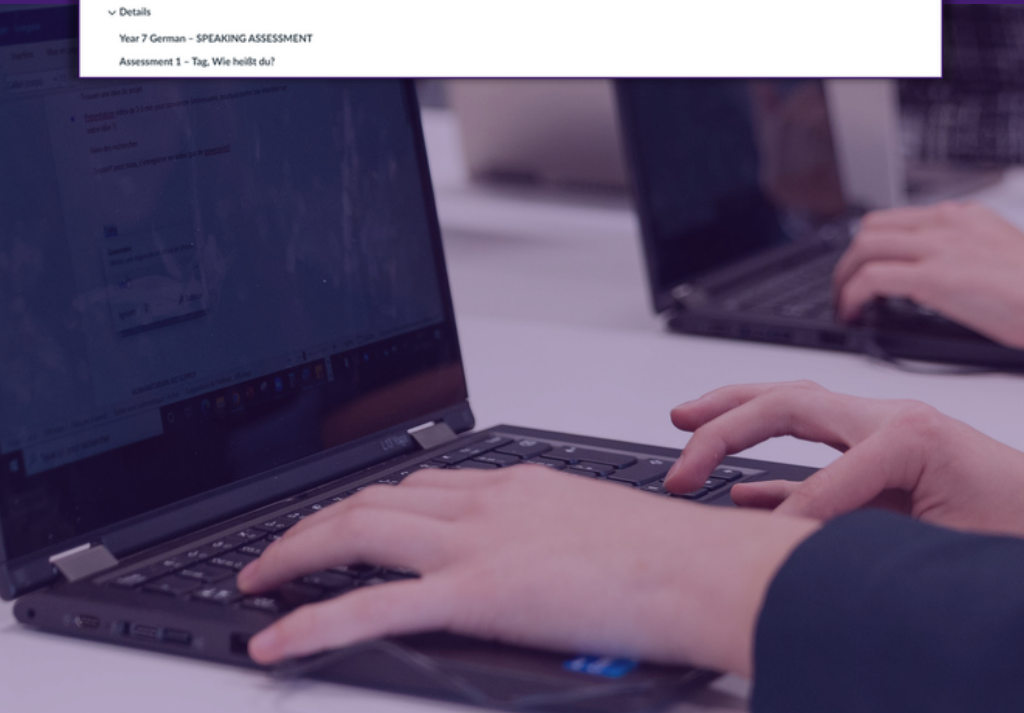
